- 1. CAPABILITY. DOES THE INSTITUTION HAVE THE CAPACITY TO IMPLEMENT, SUSTAIN, AND COMPLETE THE QEP?
- 2. INVOLVEMENT. WILL THE INSTITUTION BE ABLE TO ENSURE ON-GOING INVOLVEMENT OF ALL ESSENTIAL INSTITUTIONAL CONSTITUENTS TO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE QEP?
- **3. ASSESSMENT.** WILL THE INSTITUTION BE ABLE TO ENSURE THAT MEASURE OF STUDENT LEARNING AND SUCCESS CAN BE DOCUMENTED THROUGHOUT AND AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE QEP?
