III. Committee Service to the University

Reminded members bout the UAC's purpose. UAC members assist our institution by improving assessment reporting procedures as well as evaluate the assessments themselves to ensure that departments are collecting meaningful data and using it for continuous improvement of their programs.

• Regional accreditation requires institutional commitment to the concept of quality enhancement through continuous assessment and improvement.
