

A Morphometric Analysis of the *Cyperus squarrosus*-*Cyperus granitophilus* Complex in North America, with the Description of a New Variety of *Cyperus squarrosus*

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ABSTRACT

Morphometric data were used to investigate the relationship between *Cyperus squarrosus* and related *C. granitophilus*, with particular attention to populations of *C. granitophilus* recently reported from granite outcrops in Texas and Oklahoma. Data for 23 characters (variables) taken from 406 voucher specimens were analyzed using principal component analysis (PCA), discriminant analysis (DA), multivariate analysis of variance (MANOVA), and a Euclidian distance dendrogram. Results (1) strongly support the treatment of *C. granitophilus* and *C. squarrosus* as separate species but (2) provide at best weak evidence for formal recognition of *C. squarrosus* var. *runcyonii* and (3) indicate that the Texas and Oklahoma populations recently reported as *C. granitophilus* are more closely related to *C. squarrosus* than *C. granitophilus*.

INTRODUCTION

The granite outcrops of the southeastern United States are characterized by highly exfoliated rock surfaces with little to no soil and communities comprising crustose lichens, mosses, and specialized plants that occur around ephemeral pools and shallow soil pockets formed on the otherwise harsh, inhospitable rock (Burbanck and Platt 1964). Such systems give rise to unique plant communities, and their high potential for endemism has attracted the attention of botanists and ecologists. One such endemic is *Cyperus granitophilus* McVaugh, a relative of the generalist *C. squarrosus* L. Both *C. granitophilus* and *C. squarrosus* are diminutive heliophytic annual sedges with the characteristic odor of fenugreek and are sympatric in these granite outcrop communities. Noticing two strikingly different size classes on the rocky outcrops, McVaugh (1937) postulated that *C. granitophilus* was an undescribed species related to, but distinct from, *C. squarrosus* [as *C. inflexus* Muhlenberg]. McVaugh also highlighted other characters, such as spikelet length and width, scale number, scale length, scale nerve number, and presence of an achene stipe as important in distinguishing between the two species. Kral (1983) noted the longer anther of *C. granitophilus* as an additional diagnostic feature. Based upon their evidence that *C. granitophilus* was a polyploid derivative of *C. squarrosus* [as *C. inflexus*], Garoni and Murdy (1964) argued against species rank for *C. granitophilus*. However, the current treatment in the *Flora of North America* (Tucker et al. 2002) and Weakley (2020) maintain them as distinct species, distinguished by scale width, nerve number, anther length, and filament length. Kral (1983) and Weakley (2020) expanded the habitat description to include seasonally wet pools, seeps, and banks of intermittent streams on a variety of rock substrates in addition to granite, including sandstone and limestone in middle Tennessee, diabase flatrock in the Piedmont, and

Altamaha Grit glade outcrops in southcentral Georgia. We have not seen vouchers from Georgia Altamaha Grit outcrops.

Recently, disjunct populations of *Cyperus granitophilus* were reported from the Llano Uplift of central Texas and the Wichita Mountains and Arbuckle Uplift of Oklahoma (O'Kennon and Taylor 2015). The Texas, Oklahoma, and southeastern piedmont plants identified as *C. granitophilus* share markedly similar habitats, plant communities, and geology (O'Kennon and Taylor 2015; Taff 1928), and O'Kennon and Taylor (2015) argue that these plants have been consistently misidentified as *C. squarrosus* due to the absence of *C. granitophilus* from regional floras and suggest that they may represent relictual populations from the cooler and moister Pleistocene conditions.

Our interest in this problem dates to 1989 when the second author vouchered similar plants [Carter 8214 (BRIT-VDB, VSC)] from a granite outcrop in Mason County, Texas, and called them *Cyperus granitophilus*. However, because of certain ambiguities in these vouchers, he chose not to report them until a more thorough study could be conducted, hence our present endeavor. Results from a preliminary analysis of the *Cyperus squarrosus*-*C. granitophilus* complex in Georgia were presented by Lowe and Carter (2016).

The objectives of this research are (1) to examine critically the relationship between *Cyperus squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus* to determine whether they are morphologically distinct, using a broader suite of characters, (2) to include recently reported records of *C. granitophilus* from Texas and Oklahoma to assess their relationship with southeastern material of *C. granitophilus*, and (3) to evaluate the relationship of an obscure, narrowly endemic taxon from Texas, *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (O'Neill) S.D. Jones & Wipff, to both the *C. squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus*.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

We examined 406 specimens from the following herbaria: BRIT, GA, NY, SMU, VDB, TAES, VSC (Thiers 2018). Three-hundred thirty-one specimens had been identified *a posteriori* as *C. squarrosus* and 75 as *C. granitophilus*, including Texas and Oklahoma specimens cited as *C. granitophilus* by O'Kennon and Taylor (2015). These source specimens for our morphometric analysis are identified in the appendix by citing the herbarium in bold font where each resides. A critical study of vouchers and the literature (McVaugh 1937; Radford et al. 1968; Kral 1983; Carter et al. 1999; Carter and Bryson 2000; Tucker et al. 2002; O'Kennon and Taylor 2015) revealed 24 potentially informative characters (i.e., variables) for analysis (Table 1), although one variable, distance from achene base to point of its maximum width [ACHMX], was only used in the calculation of the ratio of the distance from achene base to its point of maximum width:achene length [ACHMX/ACHL], a proxy for achene outline (cf. Carter and Bryson 2000). The measurements for all 24 characters were recorded in an Excel spreadsheet along with a unique identifier [collector name in combination with collection number (or date) and source herbarium] linked to each source specimen. Each character was measured on each of the source specimens. Fine details were measured to the nearest 0.1 mm using an Olympus SZ 51 stereo dissecting microscope and a Minitool Micro-Scale (minitool, Inc., Campbell, California). The resulting measurements were recorded in an Excel spreadsheet. The data were subjected to principal component analysis (PCA), discriminant analysis (DA), multivariate analysis of variance (MANOVA), and a Euclidian distance dendrogram using Minitab 17 (2010). The initial PCA scatter plot grouped by the *a priori* determinations, formed two distinct clusters, and the PCA highlighted variables significant as to variance between the taxa. Our data were then subjected to DA to identify specimens that may have been misclassified, and any such specimens were reexamined and reclassified as necessary. These determinations were then checked against MANOVA of all variables with the specimen determination as the model, and the variance between the variables was analyzed using ANOVA to examine the relationship of the variances within and among the taxa for a given variable. Ranges, means, and standard deviation for each variable are depicted as box plots with outliers (specimens outside the second standard deviation from the mean) shown.

Electron micrographs were made using a JEOL JSM-6480LV (JEOL, Peabody, Massachusetts) scanning electron microscope. Representative achenes were harvested from specimens and mounted to glass cover slips with double-stick carbon tape on aluminum stubs. The stubs were then imaged on low magnification (85X) using a secondary electron detector. The resulting images were edited for contrast.

To map the distribution of *C. squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus* in the United States, data were taken from labels of physical specimens and from digital images accessed through the SERNEC portal (2018). Physical vouchers were borrowed from BRIT, GA, NY, SMU, VDB, TAES, and VSC, and digital data were taken from records in ARIZ, ASC, ASU, BOON, BRY, BUT, CLEMS, CM, COLO, CS, DBG, DES, DUKE, EIU, EKY, EMC, F, FARM, FLAS, FSU, FUGR, GEO, GMUF, GSW, HUNT, HWBA, IBE, ILLS, IND, KNK, LL, LSU, MARY, MCA, MICH, MISS, MISSA, MMNS, MO, MOR, MSUB, MUR, MWI, NCSC, NCU, NMC, NO, SRSC, TENN, TEX, TROY, TTRS, UARK, UCAC, UCR, UNCC, URV, USCH, USCS, USFS, USMS, USU, UT, UTM, UWFP, VPI and WIS (Thiers 2018). Identifications of all specimen records from which data were derived virtually were checked via their associated images. Virtual records are indicated by an asterisk next to the herbarium code in the appendix. Maps were generated in ESRI's ArcMap (ESRI 2021) using county level data from the herbarium records. All base maps were obtained from the United States Geological Survey (Georgia GIS Clearinghouse, USGS, Savannah, Georgia).

RESULTS

Results of PCA (Table 1, Figures 1 and 2) support the recognition of *C. granitophilus* as a species distinct from *C. squarrosus*. The eigenvalues indicate principal components (PC) 1 and 2 accounted for 58.9% of the total variance. The variables floral scale length [SCALL], width of widest spikelet [SPKLTW], anther length [ANTHL], and achene width [ACHW] affected variance of PC1 most (Table 1), whereas the most impactful variables of PC2 were length of longest ray [RAYL], number of rays [RAYN], length of longest primary inflorescence bract [BRCTL], and culm length [CULML] (Table 1). The most informative variables of PC3 were number of floral scales per spikelet [SCLN], length of longest spikelet [SPKLTL], width of widest spike [SPKW], and length of longest spike [SPKL] (Table 1). The results of the DA (Table 2) generally supported the PCA groupings (Figures 1 and 2), highlighting only seven outlier specimens of *C. squarrosus*, all from tropical regions. The dendrogram (Figures 3–6) further confirmed this, separating the two taxa with only 4 tropical outliers. Both sets of outliers were reexamined and their determinations confirmed. The results of the MANOVA (Table 3) showed that the differences between the taxa were significant (p -value < 0.001).

The PCA also shows that specimens from Texas and Oklahoma identified as *C. granitophilus* by O'Kennon and Taylor (2015) do not group with *C. granitophilus* specimens from rock outcrops mostly from the piedmont region of the southeastern United States. In the scatter plot of PC1 and PC2 (Figure 1), these Texas and Oklahoma specimens cluster primarily with *C. squarrosus* with a few individuals appearing possibly intermediate between *C. squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus*. Moreover, when PC3 was included with PC1 and PC2 in a three-dimensional scatter plot (Figure 2), this group from Texas and Oklahoma diverged strongly from southeastern *C. granitophilus* specimens (Figures 3 and 5), based primarily on differences in number of floral scales per spikelet [SCALN]. Boxplots (Figures 7 and 8) and integral plots (Figures 9 and 10) further confirmed the disparity in the variance of these characters, showing that the characters of the disjunct putative *C. granitophilus* populations from Texas and Oklahoma did not exhibit many similarities in diagnostic characters.

DISCUSSION

Are *Cyperus squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus* distinct species?

Scatter plots show two distinct groups (Figures 1 and 2). Thus, our results support recognition of *C. granitophilus* and *C. squarrosus* as distinct species and indicate floral scale length [SCALL], width of widest spikelet [SPKLTW], and anther length [ANTHL] are most reliable characters for




Figure 1. Scatter plot of principal components 1 and 2, with southeastern piedmont *C. granitophilus* (SE GR), putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* (TX GR?), *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (RU), and *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* separated by temperate (Temp SQ) or tropical (Trop SQ) origin.





Figure 2. Scatter plot of principal components 1, 2, and 3 showing southeastern piedmont *C. granitophilus* (SE GR), putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* (TX GR?), *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (RU), and *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* separated by temperate (Temp SQ) and tropical (Trop SQ) origin.

separating them. Anther length [ANTHL], first noted by Kral (1983), is the most important diagnostic character, showing almost no overlap between the two species (Figures 7c and 9c). McVaugh (1937) and Weakley (2020) cite the short-stipitate achene base as diagnostic: present in *C. squarrosus* (Figure 11a) and absent in *C. granitophilus* (Figure 11b). Except for a few individuals, this trait was a reliable diagnostic character for distinguishing between the two species. The seven specimens highlighted by the DA were all *C. squarrosus* outliers from the tropics, which were nearly twice the average size of most temperate North American *C. squarrosus* plants (Table 4). The largest of these were isolated by the dendrogram (Figures 3 and 6) and grouped together, but not with *C. granitophilus*. Other than their larger overall height, these specimens lack any diagnostic characters of *C. granitophilus*, and apparently none were collected from granite outcrops. *Cyperus squarrosus* showed a high degree of morphological variability, and additional investigation is needed to develop a better understanding of its variation on a worldwide basis with a special emphasis on the large tropical specimens that differ greatly from the expected morphological bounds of the species, as it is expressed in temperate North America.




Figure 4. Group 1, *Cyperus granitophilus* portion of the Euclidian dendrogram.




Figure 5. Group 2, *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* portion of the Euclidean dendrogram; putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* specimens marked with an exclamation point (!) and *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* specimens marked with an asterisk (*).




Figure 6. Group 3, *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* large tropical specimens from the Yucatan Peninsula, Mexico [Gaumer and Mears] and Zambia [Robinson] portion of the Euclidean dendrogram.

What is the status of *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *runyonii*?




Figure 11. Scanning electron micrographs of achenes. (a) *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*—a' Carter 8007 (VSC), a'' McDonald 7656 (VSC), a''' Gaumer 1023 (NY); (b) southeastern piedmont *C. granitophilus*—b' Radford 45275 (VDB), b'' Kral 60904 (VSC), b''' Kral 59130 (VDB); (c) *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus*—c' O'Kennon 26142 (BRIT), c'' Taylor 2776 (BRIT), c''' O'Kennon 26145a (BRIT); (d) *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii*—d' Gould 8525 (SMU), d'' Lott 5105 (BRIT), d''' Jones 1470 (SMU).

In Figure 1, *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* specimens are scattered within the *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* cloud, indicating a close affinity with this taxon (Figure 1). The spatuloid achene (Figure 11d) appears to be the only character that distinguishes *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *runyonii* from *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*, and all other characters of *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* fall within the ranges of *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*. The dendrogram nests *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* within the broader *C. squarrosus* group; however, specimens of *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* do not form a distinct cluster (Figure 5). The paucity of specimens of *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* suggests it occurs only sporadically within the range of *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*. However, given its odd achene morphology, varietal status for *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* remains useful, if for no other reason than to bring it to the attention of field botanists who are likely to find additional populations that would provide the basis for a better understanding of this enigmatic taxon.

Does *Cyperus granitophilus* occur in Texas and Oklahoma?

Texas and Oklahoma specimens recently reported as *Cyperus granitophilus* by O'Kennon and Taylor (2015) fall within the *C. squarrosus* cloud in the two-dimensional score plot (Figure 1).




Figure 7. Boxplot of four most important characters of PC 1 (a-d) and PC 2 (e-h) for southeastern *C. granitophilus* (SE-GR), putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* (TX-GR?), *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (RU), and *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* separated between temperate (Temp SQ) and tropical (Trop SQ).




Figure 8. Boxplot of four most important characters of PC3 for southeastern *C. granitophilus* (SE-GR), putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* (TX-GR?), *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (RU), and *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* separated between temperate (Temp SQ) and tropical (Trop SQ).

Several of these specimens form the edge of this cluster, and one was highlighted as a possible intermediate between *C. squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus*. All of these peripheral specimens were carefully reexamined and found to lack the critical diagnostic features of *C. granitophilus*, i.e., longer anthers, longer floral scales, and estipitate achenes. Thus, we interpret them as unusually large *C. squarrosus* plants. The three-dimensional scatter diagram incorporating PC1, PC2, and PC3 (Figure 2) shows a clear separation of these Texas and Oklahoma plants from *C. granitophilus*. The most informative characters in PC3 are number of floral scales per spikelet [SCALN] and length of longest spikelet [SPKLTL], which differ consistently between *C. squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus*, with *C. granitophilus* having fewer but larger floral scales on relatively short spikelets, and the Texas and Oklahoma specimens having a greater number of smaller floral scales on longer spikelets.

Although these granite outcrop plants of Texas and Oklahoma share some similarities (e.g., culm length, achene shape) with *C. granitophilus* from the southeastern piedmont and adjacent physiographic provinces, most of the diagnostic characters fall within the range of *C. squarrosus* or between *C. squarrosus* and *C. granitophilus* (Table 4). The Texas and Oklahoma plants have longer spikelets and larger spikes more characteristic of southeastern *C. granitophilus*; however, the greater length of their spikelets is due to a greater number of smaller floral scales (Figures 7a, 8a, 9a and 10a). These specimens also lack the longer anthers and estipitate achenes diagnostic of *C. granitophilus*. Although the Texas and Oklahoma plants are generally taller than typical *C. squarrosus*, it is not unusual for plants of *C. squarrosus* from the tropics to exhibit culms exceeding even those of *C. granitophilus*. Interestingly, the three-dimensional scatter plot of PC1, PC2, and PC3 (Figure 2) shows these specimens dispersed along a different vector from the rest of *C. squarrosus*, which suggests that these Texas and Oklahoma plants represent an incipient convergent ecotype arising out of the local populations of *C. squarrosus*, perhaps adapting to similar environmental conditions as *C. granitophilus* in granite and other rock outcrops east of the




Figure 9. Integral plot of four most important characters of PC 1 and 2 for southeastern *C. granitophilus* (SE-GR), putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* (TX-GR?), *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (RU), and *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* separated between temperate (Temp SQ) and tropical (Trop SQ).




Figure 10. Integral Plot of four most important characters of PC3 for southeastern *C. granitophilus* (SE-GR), putative Texas and Oklahoma *C. granitophilus* (TX-GR?), *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii* (RU), and *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* separated between temperate (Temp SQ) and tropical (Trop SQ).

Mississippi River. Thus, we conclude the Texas and Oklahoma specimens assigned to *C. granitophilus* by O'Kennon and Taylor (2015) fall within the range of variation of *C. squarrosus* and are better treated as a variety of this species, as follows.

Diagnosis—*Cyperus squarrosus* var. *graniticus* differs from *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* in the following ways: *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus* is a larger plant than most temperate zone plants of

C. squarrosus var. *squarrosus* and has longer spikelets than *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*—the greater spikelet length resulting from a greater number of floral scales per spikelet, not from larger scales. The achenes of *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus* have the diagnostic short stipe of *C. squarrosus* and generally exhibit a lower length to width ratio than *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*, with a more strongly obovoid outline. In contrast with *C. granitophilus*, the achenes of *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus* are smaller and only weakly obpyramidal and have stipitate bases. *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *graniticus* also lacks the diagnostic long anther of *C. granitophilus*.

Ecology and Distribution—*Cyperus squarrosus* var. *graniticus* inhabits granitic uplifts in Oklahoma and Texas, characterized by harsh exfoliated rock, shallow soils, and seasonal, ephemeral pools. Figures 12, 13, and 14 show the distributions of *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus*, *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus*, *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii*, and *C. granitophilus*, as interpreted by us.

Etymology—The name *graniticus* refers to the granitic substrate characteristic of this new variety.

 - 2b. Achene spatuloid to obpyramidal to obovoid; spikelets 5.8–9.7 mm long; plants narrowly distributed west of the Mississippi River. 3
 - 3a. Achene spatuloid, abruptly wider at the apex; plants restricted to southern Texas *C. squarrosus* var. *runyonii*
 - 3b. Achene weakly obpyramidal to obovoid; plants restricted to granite outcrops west of the Mississippi River (Texas and Oklahoma) *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus*






Figure 13. County-level distribution in the south-central United States of *Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* (closed circles), *C. s.* var. *graniticus* (closed triangles), and *C. s.* var. *runyonii* (crosses).

Figure 12. County-level distribution in the United States of *Cyperus squarrosus*-*Cyperus squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* (closed circles), *C. s.* var. *runyonii* (crosses), and *C. squarrosus* var. *graniticus* (closed triangles). Large-scale maps corresponding with boxed areas are provided in figures 13 (A) and 14 (B).




Figure 14. County-level distribution in the southeastern United States of *Cyperus granitophilus* (closed circles) and *C. squarrosus* var. *squarrosus* (crosses); counties with both taxa are indicated by closed circles superimposed on crosses.
