In collaboration with Georgia Botanical Society, the Coastal Plain Chapter of the Georgia Native Plant Society is offering a 2-day workshop on native sedges at Gaskins Forest Education Center in Alabama. The workshop will be led by Dr. Richard Carter of Valdosta State University, who teaches Botany and Plant Systematics and is the VSU Herbarium Curator. He has published 'An Introduction to the Sedges of Georgia'.

The first day of the workshop will be classroom-based starting at 10 am and the second day will be field-based starting at 9 am. Richard will provide downloadable online resources (classroom presentations) to people who have registered before the event.
