Dear Art Education Major:

The Bachelor of Fine Arts with a major in art education prepares students for initial art education certification (p-12). The program prepares art educators with the knowledge, skills, and experiences necessary to be successful in an array of potential career choices: p-12 studio art teacher, museum educator, community center educator or continuing student (to a graduate program). Art educators inspire students around the world, playing a vital role in the lives of children and adults who are interested in art. Students take classes within the art program but have additional classes in education and Art Education, as well as field experience outside of the university. Students are encouraged to join the NAEA student chapter to guide them professionally into the field of art education and provide conference experience.

The academic maps provide a term-by-term sample course schedule. The milestones listed below each term are reminders to keep you on course to graduate in four years. Sample schedules are a general guideline to help you build a full schedule each term. The earlier semesters require heavier course loads to accommodate the final semester of clinical practice in a local p-12 public school. Courses must be selected with your academic advisor to satisfy all core, major curriculum, and meet accreditation standards.

The Art Education program within Valdosta State University is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art (NASAD). CAEP (Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation) and GaPSC (Georgia Professional Standards Commission) requirements. The National Art Education Association (NAEA) and Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) provides program standards, curricular guidelines, and assessment tools that help to ensure a quality program in art education.

This program is 129 hours. The student must average between 16 and 18 hours each semester to graduate within a four-year period or take six hours over two or three summer school sessions. Core and Education courses may be taken during the summer. Students who complete the major in Art Education will graduate with a Bachelor of Fine Arts - Art Education degree.
