PROJECT BRIEF

Our second assignment exploring the types of “output” or equipment used in creating art with technology will be for the laser cutter that is currently housed in the woodshop. We will use Adobe Illustrator to create simple line art drawings that will be sent to the laser cutter for cutting out areas of your design.
