

Supply List for ARID 2111 and ARID 2310

ARID 2111 – Interior Design Studio I

Drafting Rulers, Scales, and Straight edges:

- Architectural Scale
- 24" metal ruler with cork backing
- 14" 45-degree triangle (a smaller too may be helpful)
- 14" 30 / 60-degree triangle (a smaller one too may be helpful)
- Home furnishings template 1/4" = 1'-0" scale – such as TD7161
- Plumbing template 1/4" = 1'-0" scale - Rapid Design 25R
- Small/ Large circle template combo – T-831
- Small / large elliptical template combo
- Ames lettering guide
- Erasing shield

Pencils, Lead Holders, Pens:

- Lead Holders 2mm in size – 1 required (soft lead and hard lead) – 3 preferred (for medium lead)
- Drafting Leads – 4B, 2B, B, HB, F, H, 2H, 4H - purchase sets of 6 leads each
- Lead Pointer (Sharpener) - airtight container or baggie to contain the dust is needed. (Alvin alp44 rotary lead pointer is preferred)
- Good quality drawing pens – Micron, Prismacolor, Le Pen, Sharpie, etc... with sets of 4 or 6 that have black ink with various tip sizes. Avoid brush tips.... .9mm is a good maximum size .1, .3. .5. .7mm etc...
- Organizer for leads and lead holders

Papers:

- Tracing paper on a roll 36" wide by 50 yds. (White is best / canary is acceptable) – 24" roll is helpful too.
- Vellum sheets in booklet form 18" x 24" or 19" x 24" sold as 50 sheets or more. (Canson C702-445, Clearprint Design Vellum)

Other items:

- Erasers – **white** vinyl sold as rectangle blocks, or as mechanical eraser with refills. (X 2, minimum)
- Eraser pencils
- Pencil sharpener for erasers and color pencils
- Something to put your supplies in. – tackle boxes work well as do art caddies –
- X-acto knife and refill blades – please purchase one with a blade cover or that is retractable and blade refills
- Self-healing cutting board- No Smaller than 12" x 18". NO larger than 18" x 24"
- Good scissors
- Drafting brush
- Drafting dots / tape

Optional items to consider:

- Mechanical drafting pencils - .3mm .5mm .7mm and lead refill matching leads for lead holders.
- Glues/adhesives – good clear stick glues, clear tacky glue, rubber cement or spray adhesive – avoid hot glue.
- Compass instead of circle templates
- Cleaning supplies (wipes, etc.) to help clean drafting equipment, desks and hands.
- Carrying tube for working drawings
- Portfolio to transport finished work or boards

- Pastel colors – tend to blend better

 - Shinhan Art
 - Prismacolor
 - Tria-Pantone

Papers:

- Graphics paper – book form 14” x 17” for use with markers (Bienfang Graphics 360 Marker Paper)
