Rodgers + Hammerstein's CINDERELLA

is the new Broadway adaptation of the classic musical. CINDERELLA was originally produced for television in 1957 and starred Julie Andrews. It was remade for television in 1965 with Leslie Ann Warren and in 1997 with Brandy and Whitney Houston. The original Broadway production opened in 2013.

This contemporary take on the classic tale of Cinderella's desire to attend a ball, features some of Rodgers + Hammerstein's most beloved songs, including "In My Own Little Corner," "Impossible/It's Possible," and "Ten Minutes Ago." The new adaptation features a hilarious and romantic libretto by Tony Award nominee Douglas Carter Beane.
