- ✓ OAT majors may take NO MORE than 30 hours of coursework from the College of Business.
- ✓ OAT majors must have an overall minimum 2.3 GPA before enrolling in the following ACED courses: ACED 4020, 4030, 4050, 4070, and 4160.
- ✓ <u>ALL ACED COURSEWORK</u> must be completed before enrolling in ACED 4300B
- ✓ **Business or business casual attire is required for internships.** It is mandatory for OAT majors to attend one of the Successful Dress & Interview Tips workshops offered by the Career Services office prior to enrolling in the internship practicum (ACED 4300B)
- ✓ Interns must attend the ACED 4300B pre-internship placement seminar held during the FALL and SPRING semesters. Students who have not attended the seminar and who have not been cleared to intern will be withdrawn from the class.
- ✓ All interns are required to work a total of 220 hours for the internship. For Fall and Spring interns, this means approximately 15 hours per week for 15 weeks. The Summer session is 8 weeks, so this means approximately 28 work hours per week for Summer interns.
