# Preparing to Register for Classes

- The [Program of Study](#) outlines all of the required courses for your academic program. In addition, the semester each of the courses are offered is outlined. Some courses are only offered once or twice a year.
- [Three elective courses](#) are required for your academic program.
- It is important to determine an appropriate [course load](#) to successfully navigate through your academic program.
- [Registration](#) occurs in Banner
- [Waitlisting](#) a VSU course in Banner
  - GOML courses cannot be waitlisted
- The EDAT 5999: Professional Orientation course is required your first semester in the Curriculum and Instruction in Accomplished Teaching program.



# Preparing to Start the Program

- You should be employed as an educator to successfully complete this program.
- Summer and fall 2020 GOML registration starts on April 1<sup>st</sup> at 12:01am.
- VSU fall 2020 registration starts opens March 30<sup>th</sup> at 7am.
- To be recommended for graduation and program completion, you **must** attempt the GACE for Curriculum and Instruction **prior to graduation**.

- Typically, individuals need a minimum of five credit hours for financial aid

  - The 2020-2021 FAFSA includes fall 2020, spring 2021 and summer 2021

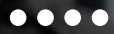
