

Preparing to Register for Classes

- The <u>Program of Study</u> outlines all of the required courses for your academic program. In addition, the semester each of the courses are offered is outlined. Some courses are only offered twice a year.
- <u>Two elective courses</u> are required for your academic program.
- It is important to determine an appropriate <u>course</u> <u>load</u> to successfully navigate through your academic program.
- <u>Registration</u> occurs in Visual Schedule Builder
- The EDUC 5999: Professional Orientation course is required the first semester. Please register for the FDUC 5999 FLF section course.

How to wait list for a VSU course that is full
