The meeting was called to order at 10:00am by Dr. Andrews presiding in EC 2150.

Dr. Oliver wanted everyone to introduce themselves. Everyone in the room said a short introduction of their name and their connection to the department.

Dr. Andrews told him about the department as a total.

The Symposium is April 9-13, more information can be found on the website. We have 20 proposal from the department this year. EDUC 2120 students presented last year and did a great job, Dr. Andrews thanked Dr. Lu for doing a great job working with the students.

Curriculum Proposals

Curriculum meeting was held on November 28, 2017, minutes from the meeting were handed out. All ECED and ECSC courses were supposed to be changed to ELED but the concern was that Deaf Ed did not have SPED courses it would hurt their accreditation. The SPED courses that Deaf Ed takes in our department will change from ECSE to ELES. All other Elementary Education courses will change from ECED to ELED. No changes to the LITR courses.

The graduate program has been approved by the COEHS Executive Committee on 1/18/18 and will meet with the Academic Committee on 2/5/18 for approval. Handouts were distributed.

Changes to the K-5 Endorsement course were reviewed. Suggestions were made for corrections. Dr. Andrews will make necessary changes and send electronic for approval.
