Minutes Approved: Minutes from the meeting of October 29, 2012 were approved.

Discussion:

Ike Barton shared the following IT updates:

- 1. **Mobile Device Management (MDM).** *LANDesk MDM* should be deployed fully by the end of February. A *LANDesk* agent will need to be installed on mobile devices and tablets for users to have access to apps provided by the University.
- 2. Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP). The new phone system is being deployed internally in the next 5-7 days, and then it will be rolled out to campus departments beginning in March. Voicemail can be set up to go to email on the new system. New phones will be delivered to individuals along with go-live dates for each phone number.
- 3. Office 365. VSU will be migrating from *Windows Live* to *Office 365*, except for *Skydrive*, sometime in May.

Amanda King-Spezzo shared the following eLearning updates:

4. Desire2Learn (D2L).

- a. VSU courses currently taught with BlazeVIEW will go to **BlazeVIEW D2L** beginning Maymester, 2013. VSU is keeping the "BlazeVIEW" brand for its online courses.

- c. Faculty who attended an Introduction to GoVIEW workshop do not need to attend the introductory workshop to sign up for intermediate workshops.
- d. Content is expected to be migrated from Blackboard Vista 8 to BlazeVIEW D2L by mid-March.
