PROGRAM ADMISSION ASSESSMENT

Per GaPSC rules, passing or exempting the Program Admission Assessment (PAA) is required for all candidates admitted into an educator preparation program at Valdosta State University. Students are able to either pass the PAA or exempt through several methods. Table 1 shows the number of admits who passed the PAA or their method of exemption. Table 2 looks more closely at admitted students who passed the PAA by reporting their performance on each of the three tests.
