MFT Program Policy on Technology Requirements

The VSU MFT program requires that all MFT students acquire and/or learn to operate the following technology:

- 1. a <u>VSU email address</u> throughout the time in the program
- 2. basic Word and Excel skills
- 3. phone and/or email availability, especially while clinically active
- 4. Time2Track, client and supervision contact hours tracking software
- 5. Endura, the FamilyWorks video recording system
 - a. Endura is quite simple, and students learn to use it by using it. Nonetheless, at the beginning of the Fall semester 2nd Year orientation to practica and internships, the Clinic Director trains students on the use of Endura.
- 6. if taking a course that uses Daylight, online Daylight training
