Statement of MFT Compliance with VSU Technology Policies, Procedures,

The MFT Program complies with VSU Information Technology governance structures to manage, contain, and recover from breaches, provide training and systems oversight, reduce risk and reinforce security, and maintain operational readiness by implementing these policies in cases of actual breach, at which point Information Technology is responsible for monitoring computing systems, restricting access until issues are resolved when threats are detected, and taking actions (e.g., isolating threats, coordinating response efforts) to protect the network.

Purpose MFT Technology Policy

Technology is a vital component of the MFT Program. Students are expected to maintain the necessary tools and skills to:

- engage fully in academic and clinical training
- receive important university and program communications
- participate in online learning environments
- meet ethical and legal standards of client confidentiality

By understanding and adhering to this Technology Policy, students will be well-prepared for academic success and professional development throughout the MFT Program.

Technology Requirements for MFT Students

The MFT program requires that all MFT students possess or have easy access desktop, laptop, or tablet. All VSU and MFT Program communication occurs through VSU email; thus, successful completion of the MFT degree requires the following.

1. reliable internet access
2. web browsing capabilities
3. a VSU email address throughout the time in the program
4. Calendar application (Outlook preferred)
5. basic skills using Word, Excel, Power Point, or Canva or other presentation software
6. cell phone availability, especially while clinically active
7. Regular access to [BlazeView](#), the VSU learning management system

Valt is configured to restrict the downloading of confidential materials to authorized faculty members only. Students are permitted to download such materials solely with documented faculty authorization and in strict accordance with the Program's Policy on Technology.
