The online Master of Education in Higher Education Leadership can help you prepare for professional administrative, leadership, and student-oriented positions and career advancement opportunities in a variety of post-secondary settings.

The sample course rotation below is designed for a full-time graduate student who begins in the Fall semester and will graduate in five semesters. The course rotation will be modified at the discretion of the Higher Education Leadership program faculty for working professionals who wish to attend part time. Those students typically graduate in six semesters, depending on the number of classes they enroll in each semester.
