

NEW for FALL 2019: Two \$1,000 Merryll Penson MLIS Scholarships

The Department of Library and Information Studies in the Dewar College of Education and Human Services is excited to announce two new \$1,000 Merryll Penson Scholarships for the fall 2019 semester. Merryll Penson is the retired Executive Director of Library Services in the Office of Instructional and Information Technology in the University System of Georgia. These scholarships are made possible by many generous donations made in honor of Merryll Penson on the occasion of her retirement from the University System of Georgia. Applications for these scholarships are due April 21.

Application Guidelines:

A. To be eligible for a Merryll Penson \$1000 Scholarship applicants must:

1. Be accepted into the MLIS degree program and registered for a minimum of six (6) credits of MLIS courses for Fall 2019
2. Have documented indication of financial need in the form of a current FAFSA on file in the VSU Office of Financial Aid
3. Have a Valdosta State Graduate GPA of 3.5 or higher
4. No MLIS course grade lower than a B (3.0)

B. To apply:

1. Submit a letter of application including a brief profile of your career goals and your progress towards those goals so far. Include in your application letter a statement that you can document financial need because you have a FAFSA on file with the VSU Office of Financial Aid. Your letter must include your VSU Student Identification number (870-xx-xxxx) and your VSU email address.
2. Complete a Program of Study form with your MLIS Program advisor. Your Program of Study form must include a list of the courses you have completed as well as those you are planning to take, grades for all courses you have completed. The blank Program of Study form is located on the MLIS Academic Advising webpage under Program of Study Form: <http://www.valdosta.edu/colleges/education/master-of-library-and-information-science/student-resources/advising.php>
3. Submit your application letter and your program of study to your MLIS advisor. After review your advisor will forward your application to the MLIS Program Director
4. Recipients of a Merryll Penson MLIS scholarship must be willing to submit a photo of themselves and a brief quotation of what the scholarship award means to them. This material will be forwarded to the University System of Georgia, Inc. Foundation and used in publicity related to the scholarships. By providing this material the recipients allow the USG Foundation to use them in their publications.
5. Deadline for submission of all Merryll Penson Scholarship applications is April 21, 2019.

C. Selection

1. The MLIS Awards and Scholarship Committee will review the applications.
2. All applicants will be reviewed in the Spring semester; the awards will be applied to the following Fall semester.
3. Each scholarship recipient will receive an award letter prior to the beginning of the semester in which the scholarship will be applied.

D. Procedures for Disbursement

Each semester, awards will be applied to the students' bursary account prior to the fee payment deadline. Any university fees or expenses beyond the amount of the scholarship award will be the responsibility of the student.
