Talk to Dr. Most

Dr. Most held her Spring 2017 "Talk to Dr. Most" listening session on the evening of April 13, 2017 using BlackBoard Collaborate inside MLIS Village. The online listening sessions offer a chance for students to chase down rumors, ask questions, offer suggestions, or simply share their thoughts about the MLIS degree program. These listening sessions allow both in-state and out-of-state students a chance to share their thoughts with the department head.

Seven students participated. The session was not recorded to protect the confidentiality of the process. Questions about department policies and resources were answered. One student's suggestion will result in scheduling a "Talk to Dr. Most" session every semester and holding the sessions on different nights of the week so that students who work Thursdays can participate in the semester when the session is held on Tuesday or Wednesday.

Another student asked for more details about MLIS 7800 Capstone. The group discussed the course content and Dr. Most reminded participants that all MLIS course syllabi are available on the departmental webpages.
