

COMMON CORE

Descriptor:

This is a hands-on training to guide the transition for Common Core into the daily classroom. The focus of this session will be for English/Language Arts and literacy, Social Studies, and Science teachers; unpacking the standards with real examples for their specific subject areas. Examples will be shared from all levels of K-12 curriculums. Participants will gain the understanding and develop strategies to implement standards directly into daily lessons and curriculum units. Each grade level will experience the transition of the 21st Century Skills, and how to plan for this process in their subject domains. Participants will leave the session with understanding and strategies for the implementation of the Common Core at a classroom level.
