Session 1

Session 2

What do the mentor teachers need from us to make them more effective mentor teachers?

Same procedure as Session 1, but have mentors choose different group mates. Mentors must brainstorm and suggest ideas that would make our mentors more effective mentor teachers.

10:00-10:30 Brainstorming Ideas~ What does the university need to provide for the mentor teachers to make them more effective?

10:30-11:00 Whole group discussion of finding using survey results and brainstorming responses. Compare and Contrast

Session 3

What do our students need from us that will make them more effective teachers?

What are they missing?

11:00-11:30 Brainstorming Ideas~ Remembering some of your previous students, what were they lacking? How could they have been better prepared prior to their arrival?

Give each mentor teacher a sticky note pad and have them write down their ideas. One idea per page. After 30 minutes, allow mentors to place their ideas on the topic page that is on the wall.

11:30-12:00 Whole group discussion of findings using survey results and brainstorming responses. Take a look at the charts and compare and contrast.
