MINUTES OF THE MEETING COLLEGE OF EDUCATION EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The College of Education Executive Committee met on Thursday, December 17, 2009, at 8:30 a.m. in Room 235 of the Education Center with Dean Gunter presiding. Minutes from Meeting on December 10, 2009 --- Reffel

A motion to approve the minutes of December 10, 2009 was made by Reffel and seconded by Martinez; with no discussion, changes or amendments, the minutes were approved.

Technology reports ---Sanders, Browne, et al

Sterlin Sanders reported that there were 103 calls completed. Lab upgrades for SLP 256 and PSYC 107 have been completed. Dr. Myers-Jennings requested that teaching stations in the classrooms of the SLP building be upgraded. The KSPE lab will be upgraded after the first of the year. Dr. Bauer asked that teaching stations in the PSYC building also be upgraded. Dr. Browne announced that training will be held the last week of January for computer response systems.

Curriculum Changes --- Reffel

Dr. Leech presented the Ed. D. curricular change proposals for the Leadership and Curriculum / Instruction programs. Discussion was held on the changes in the core to provide for an allowance of 18 hours of content. The proposals were tabled and sent back to committee for revisions. The Ed.D. Catalog changes for admission were discussed. The committee expressed concerns that there were no cut scores for the MAT / GRE and that the admission matrix was not present. LiveText Data --- Lee/ Gunter

Dean Gunter and Associate Dean Lee discussed that data collection, analysis and use process must be followed by the unit. LiveText was adopted in 2005 and should be used consistently throughout all programs. Department Heads are reminded to make sure that faculty have completed their LiveText requirements before they leave campus for the semester.

Research Associates for GSBA and GSSA Visioning Initiative --- Leech

Dr. Leech presented project for Research Associates for the Georgia School Boards Association and the Georgia School Superintendents and Georgia School Superintendents Association. Both organizations are requesting faculty to assist in research and literature reviews for these committees to develop "A Vision for Public Education in Georgia." Dr. Leech will forward it to department heads for dissemination to faculty. It may provide some opportunities for scholarship and service for faculty. Applications are due on January 8th.
