Brief Program Updates:

Mr. Conner reported that the Health and Science building is at the fund raising state. The goal is to raise funds as a building. October the building will be finished. The move in date is next summer. Further, the AT faculty have worked diligently last spring and this summer to rework various aspects of the AT program, especially on the clinical side.

Dr. Sanderson in the undergraduate HPE program reported that they have smaller numbers this year. The teacher certification program in the COE and department are moving towards NCATE accreditation this year.
