 - o Transfer students who complete equivalents in either course will be responsible for satisfying the Georgia Legislative Requirements for graduation

 - Humanities, Fine Arts, or Foreign Language course
 - o COMM 1100 (Human Communication), (COMM 1110) Public Speaking, or a Foreign Language recommended
- Communicating in Writing (6 hours)
- ENGL 1101 (Composition I)
 - ENGL 1102 (Composition II)
- Technology, Mathematics, & Science (11 hours)
- 8-hour Science Sequence (Biology I and II or Chemistry I and II)
 - o Recommended Options:
 - CHEM 1151K (Survey of Chemistry I) and CHEM 1152K (Survey of Chemistry II)
 - CHEM 1211/1211L (General Chemistry I with Lab) and CHEM 1212/1212L (General Chemistry II with Lab) also acceptable
 - BIOL 1010/1020L (Biology Evolution and Diversity with Lab) and BIOL 1030/1040L (Organismal Biology with Lab)
 - BIOL 1107/1107L (General Biology I with Lab) and BIOL 108/1108L (General Biology II with Lab) also acceptable
 - MATH 1401 (Elementary Statistics)
