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Policy:	Students who enter the nursing program are expected to complete all assigned academic and clinical activities. If a student develops a change in health status (including, but not limited to pregnancy, injury, and illness) that requires restrictions on his/her academic (classroom/lab) or clinical activities or limits students' ability to meet the Core Performance Standards Policy (BSN Students Only), the student must immediately notify all course faculty and the appropriate program director.
Procedure:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student must immediately notify the course coordinator of change in health status. 2. Status change must be documented in student's permanent record and faculty should encourage student to update academic advisor. 3. Advice from the program director or associate dean should be sought as needed. 4. Release form from the health care provider responsible for the ongoing care of the student is required when the restrictions are no longer necessary, and a copy is placed in the student's permanent file.
