

Page 1	<b>Psychomotor Skill Retention for Repeating Courses</b>	Approval Date:	11/8/2024 (origination)
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Policy:	Students who are unsuccessful in NURS 3102, 3201, 3202, or 4202 and repeat the course the next semester are not practicing psychomotor nursing skills for 4 to 8 months. This could result in a weakening of essential basic nursing skills. Students who fall into this category will be required to participate in clinical remediation.
Purpose:	To ensure clinical competency and safety when out of sequence and away from the bedside clinical environment for an extended period of time.
Procedure:	The student will work with their faculty advisor and the S.T.E.P. Center Director to develop a customized skill plan to demonstrate psychomotor proficiency. This plan must be completed prior to the end of the semester in which the course is repeated.  If psychomotor skill proficiency is not demonstrated, the student may not progress.
