Valdosta State University (VSU) is currently making plans to hold its 27th Sonia Kovalevsky High School Mathematics Day (SK Day). The day is named in honor of Sonia Kovalevsky, who was the first woman to earn a doctorate in mathematics. The purpose of SK Day is to introduce female high school students and high school teachers of both genders to applications of mathematics, to encourage both students and teachers to think of mathematics as an appropriate career field for women, and to assist students with the sometimes difficult transition between high school and college mathematics.

According to the participants, the previous SK Days were successful in many ways. We would very much like to have a group of students (non-freshman) and teachers from your school attend our 27th SK Day. The event is planned for *Thursday, April 18, 2024*, in the Ballroom of the Student Union at VSU. The day will include hands-on activities, workshops, and presentations for both teachers and students, as well as a non-calculator math contest for the students. There will be prizes for the math contest, as well as door prizes.

The program is free. Lunch will be provided in VSU's cafeteria. We ask only that you provide transportation to and from VSU. You may nominate up to two teachers and six female students to participate.
