CampDISCOVERY 2021 is open for registration!

This year CampDISCOVERY will be held at the VSU STEAM Center, 1302 N Patterson Street. Student drop-off will be at the rear door.

We have had to make some changes in our program due to COVID-19.

- Maximum number of children per camp reduced to 12.
- We will have curbside check-in and pick-up.
- Curbside check-in will begin at 8:30 a.m./12:30 p.m. Students will be taken directly to their classrooms rather than to a central location.
- For curbside pickup, parents will show ID and staff will bring children to the car line.
- As in past years, campers who are attending both morning and afternoon camps may eat their packed lunches (no heating or refrigeration available) in a supervised lunch area, and relax with some tabletop games and activities. Current COVID-19 protocols must be maintained during lunch break (including mask wearing and social distancing).




