
### Fall 2025 Move-In Information

#### Student will pick up their card today

- FLEX Account is a debit account that can be used on campus and at select locations off campus
- Transfer excess financial aid at the beginning of each semester
- For off campus locations and FLEX transfer dates visit vsu1card.com







- All freshmen living on campus will be required to have the All-access meal plan
  - \$2,260 per semester
  - Unlimited access to Palms Dining Hall each week
  - \$150 Dining Dollars
  - Meal Exchange can be added at an additional cost
    - 5 per week is \$200
    - 10 per week is \$350
    - Meal exchange will work at all dining retail locations daily (except Starbucks & Blazer Market)

### Parking & Transportation

- Permit is \$50 for the academic year
- In July students will get an email reminder to register their vehicle
- Car tag is your permit. No pull through or backing in.
- Make sure students review parking maps to avoid parking tickets
- Shuttle buses run the perimeter of campus from 7:30 am to 11 pm Monday – Friday
