 Implement and market outreach programs to faculty and staff departments
- Work closely with the Fitness & Marketing teams to develop collaborative programming and events
- Assist in planning & implementing events such as De-Stress Fest and other collaborative wellness events
- Manage & develop content for online instructional fitness & wellness portal
- Participate in Campus Wellness Committee and assist with campus-wide wellness events and programming
- Develop and implement social media wellness campaigns
- Work cooperatively with other Campus Recreation staff members and assist with departmental special events
- Other duties as assigned
