VSU Student Organization Excellence Program

Objective:

One of the elements of the Student Life's mission is to recognize outstanding achievements by student organizations. This program is centered around recognizing student organizations that actively participate in the VSU community. Additionally, this program seeks to encourage student organizations to attend events that are beneficial in the areas of organizational enrichment, teambuilding, networking, service, and collaboration.

How can my organization earn points?

Organizations can earn points by participating in various events and activities in the following categories: Student Life programs, events and workshops, campus community events, campus leadership events, and organization-specific events.

How will Student Life keep track of points?

For all of the Student Life & campus wide sponsored events, the organization's participation will be tracked electronically. For example, if you register a team for Relay for Life, then Student Life will verify your participation by cross-checking the Relay for Life project team roster. For organization specific events, your organization must provide documentation of completion. Your organization will do this via CampusConnect at the end of the spring semester and fill out an Excellence Application form. It's that simple!

How will organizations be recognized?

Student organizations will be recognized on the following levels, based on the number of points that the organization earns.

Organization of Excellence: 100+ points
Organization of Merit: 75-95 points

Organization meets **Standard**: 50-70 points
 Organization in **Development**: 0-45 points

In addition, all organizations who achieve **Excellence** status will be recognized in the following methods:

- Excellence Award Certificate
- Announced at the Valdosta State Student Life Awards Ceremony
- Recognized on the Student Union TVs for the first 2 weeks of school
- Recognized in a *Spectator* ad
- Free Ad in the Student Life Organization pamphlet to incoming students
- Points for Student Organization Office Space application
- **Points** for the Allocation Fee Funds Committee (if all other requirement are meet)
- **Priority** for Student Union Reserve Space

RSVPs

For any events that require the student organization to RSVP, the attendee for that event must email Doel Parrilla at daparrilla@valdosta.edu to RSVP once the registration has opened. If the attendee cannot attend, they must cancel their spot 24 hours in advance. Any student organization that fails to notify of a cancellation will lose RSVP privileges for the next designated event.
